TREASURER CHRISS STREET TO UNVEIL REDESIGNED TAX BILL AND INSERTS

(Santa Ana, CA) – Orange County Treasurer-Tax Collector Chriss W. Street, in conjunction with local high-volume print and mail provider, FSSI, invites the press to the unveiling of the newly redesigned Orange County tax bill, this Thursday, September 27 at 9:30 a.m. The bill was updated to improve readability, promote timely remittance and generally improve the tax payment process.

The bill features a watermark for security, and incorporates larger fonts which will increase the readability of the parcel number, due date and amount owed. These enhancements address the issues that have traditionally been most confusing and generated the most calls to the Treasurer – Tax Collector customer service line.

“Our office is committed to finding innovative solutions that improve the tax paying experience of all Orange County residents,” says Chriss Street. “The upgraded tax bill incorporates suggestions received by our tax associates and will make remitting tax payments easier.”

FSSI is an Orange County-based, woman-owned enterprise that prints and mails millions of statements, bills and letters every month. “Our entire team has enjoyed working with the staff at the Treasurer-Tax Collector’s office to create a bill that is simpler and much easier to read,” says Jennifer Dietz, FSSI’s President. More than 800,000 new bills will be mailed in the coming weeks according to Dietz.
