## The Tax Man Giveth and the Tax Man Taketh Away

(Santa Ana) Orange County Treasurer-Tax Collector Chriss W. Street reminds taxpayers to pay **the second installment of their property taxes which are due no later than Tuesday, April 10, 2008**. Property tax payments which do not have a U.S. Postal Service Postmark of April 10, 2008 or sooner are considered delinquent and a **10 percent penalty and costs** will be added to the amount originally due.

“Paying taxes is never fun, but our team is doing everything it can to make the experience less painful,” said Treasurer Street. “Our office will again be holding Extended Office Hours to collect payments and assist those with questions.”

### CHECK ONLINE TO SEE IF THE COUNTY OWES YOU MONEY

Each year the County Treasurer is required by law to publish a list of assets in custody of County agencies that have remained unclaimed in excess of three years. In accordance with California government code, the list was published in the Orange County Register on March 21 & 28. This year over \$1 million dollars will be escheated to the County if it goes unclaimed by May 12. “This money belongs to the Taxpayers of Orange County and not to the government. We have taken the additional step of posting the list on our webpage in hopes as many people as possible will claim what they are rightfully owed,” said Street.
